ELIGIBILITY

The **School Recycling Challenge** is open to all K-12 public and private schools located in the United States and the District of Columbia who have registered by January 16, 2012 at www.cancentral.com/RoundUp.

PRIZES

National and State Cash Awards

Beyond the money your school earns by recycling, CMI wants to reward your school. The school recycling the most aluminum beverage cans per capita between America Recycles Day (November 15, 2011) and Earth Day (April 22, 2012) is the “National Champion” winning \$5,000. Additionally, there will be a “State Champion” for each of the 50 states and the District of Columbia who will receive a prize of \$1,000. **That means, a total of \$56,000 will be given away across the country!**

Bonus Pizza Drawing – Post Your Recycling Totals

Additionally, to encourage you to post your recycling totals, there will be monthly drawings for \$50 pizza gift cards. Drawings are held every month for those posting their previous month’s recycling tally and verification information by the 22 of the following month (i.e. tallies from November would be posted by December 22). To be eligible to win pizza, post your tallies and verification information at www.cancentral.com/RoundUp by the 22nd of each month through April 22, 2012.

Official Rules

1. Qualify for the School Recycling Challenge by registering your school online by January 16, 2012 and submitting aluminum can recycling totals from November 15, 2011 to April 22, 2012 at www.cancentral.com/RoundUp with verification information. Only one registration per school will be accepted and schools must be registered to participate. If your school has previously participated, simply log in to your account and add the 2011-2012 School Recycling Challenge to your Challenges. No need to register again.
2. Open to all public and private K-12 schools in the United States and the District of Columbia.
3. The school recycling the most aluminum cans per capita from each state and the District of Columbia will receive a \$1,000 check and compete for the title of Great American Can RoundUp School Challenge "National Champion" and receive a check for \$5,000.
4. To enter the bonus pizza drawing, post your previous month's recycling totals and submit recycling verification information to www.cancentral.com/RoundUp by the 22nd of December, January, February, March, and April and qualify for a monthly drawing for a \$50 pizza gift card. Drawings are held at the end of the month and gift cards mailed the same day. A total of \$250 in pizza gift cards will be given away to schools. Winners will be notified.
5. Winners will be determined by the pounds of aluminum cans recycled per capita based on completed Recycling Log/Verification Form and recycling center verification or used beverage cans recycled receipts.
6. Verification forms must be fully completed and must have a recycling center verification stamp *or* authorized signature *or* you must send along receipts or they will be void. 7. Winners will be notified by phone, mail or email in May, 2012. Chances of winning depend on the number of recycling entries.
